Meeting call to order

R. Thibeault stated the purpose of this workshop is to follow up on the Goal setting workshop earlier this year. Stated that many items on the list can be eliminated due to timing and would like to see the focus put into the low hanging fruits for this year. All 'in progress' topics can be eliminated from the list as they are currently near completion.

- SRO- R. Thibeault stated this was clearly a bigger need and want within all and agreed the school is in need to come together jointly to find a solution and cost.
- Parking in Downtown- R. Thibeault stated this was something that needed more time to conduct
 an actual plan and look at all avenues with suggestions of the Economic Development
 Committee having the majority of the involvement. E. Hutchings stated the Economic
 Development Committee already has a full schedule and too busy for new projects but would
 bring it up at the next meeting. Board agrees it is an issue within town and should be resolved
 but many other projects are in this year's forefront to place this item on a temporary hold.
- EDC & Land Use Policy- this project is currently in progress
- Water Expansion & Collaboration- R. Thibeault stated there were already multiples items to put the focus on this later on and to put this item on hold.
- Wastewater Expansion; Capacity & Availability, to be included in CIP- Item placed on hold.
- Town Website-In progress, H. Thibodeau stated things are in progress and to receive a better contracted rate the school will join our contract however per school finance policy they must bid out work prior to a decision. Will have a decision and more progress by fall.
- Milton Free Public Library Phase 3 Renovations- On-going project currently working with the LCHIP grant.
- Revamp & Revitalize Veterans Park- Completed project
- Sewer Treatment Plant Outside Renovations- Completed project
- Plummer School House Outside Renovations- Item on hold. It was suggested that this project is placed on hold until final location of the building is decided. Discussion of a possible committee to address this similarly as the Town House Committee. E. Hutchings suggested forming a Heritage Commission.
- Town Building Upgrades (Communities Facility Chapter-Master Plan)- In progress
- Boards & Committees Workshop (Land Use Goals-Master Plan) & Local Plan Update- On hold until 2019
- Budget Season Meeting Process- In progress
- Economic Development Committee & UNH Co-Op Local Businesses and Volunteers- In progress
- Revive Historical Society- In progress

- Town Issued Emails for all Town Employees & BOS- In progress, would be part of the website plan.
- Legal costs Associated with Cleaning Town properties with prioritization- In progress
- Junk Yards- In progress
- Podium & Microphone for BOS Meetings- Completed
- Re-Open Jones brook Park- Hold. A. Lucier stated this would fall under Parks & Recreation Commission project.
- Boat Ramp/Dock at Town Beach & State Boat Launch- Hold. R. Thibeault stated this is currently
 within the Planning Board and apart of the CIP however has not been recommended by the
 Planning Board, suggestion of reverting to a Recreation Commission project.
- Existing Historical Buildings (ie move Plummer School to Farm Museum)- Hold
- Milton/Milton Mills Old Home Day- Hold, E. Hutchings suggested this be a Recreation Commission project.
- Tax Deeded Properties- In progress, H. Thibodeau stated the final date is set for August 16th,
 2018 for the full list to be completed.
- Winter Carnival Re-Vamp- Temporary hold, suggestions of Recreation Commission and Recreation Department joint effort project.
- Clean-up Town Beach (ie. Tree Removal and Replanting)- In progress, stated the Recreation Commission is responsible per warrant article, of all maintenance and monies associated.
- Eradicate Geese at Town Beach- Hold, no issues have been reported thus far for the year.
- Summer Kick Off Focus- Past possible revisit in 2019 but would fall under the Recreation Department.
- Memorial Day Celebration- Past
- BOS Stipend Donation- To be determined
- Waumback Dam Clean-Up- In progress
- Adopt a spot- 2019
- Plummers Ridge Hiking Trail System- Advertising and publicizing efforts in 2019
