Payment: Payment is not due at the time of application, but will be due prior to the Certificate of Right to Interbeing issued by the Cemetery Trustees.

The purchase price includes Perpetual Care Funds. The principal of such funds is permanently placed on deposit with the Milton Trustees of Trust Funds. The annual income from such funds is used for the maintenance of the herein specified lot(s). The remaining funds will be placed on deposit in the Expendable Trust Fund with the Milton Trustees of Trust Funds, these funds will be used for the entire cemetery including all lots, unsold areas of the cemetery, and such areas as lawn, roads, and shrubs and trees and fencing and tomb repairs which have been established by the cemetery.

Multiple cremation (up to 4) interments are allowed in a single plot (4' x 12') with a land make for each and in accordance with the then current Regulations.

The total cost of each lot shall include: Total Cost of lot -- \$600.00 in Milton Mills Cemetery.

\$200.00 for Perpetual Care Fund.

\$200.00 for Perpetual Care Fund. \$400.00 for Expendable Trust Fund.

Check should be made out to "Trustees of the Trust Fund, Milton, NH".

Cost to Record Certificate to be provided Strafford County Registry of Deeds is optional at owner's expense.

Plot Owners should notify the Trustees in writing whenever their contact information changes. In addition, if the ownership of the lot changes for any reason such as by death of the owner, the Trustees must be notified of the transfer of ownership through the estate process. The Resale of any Cemetery lot or Right to Inter shall be only to the Town of Milton and abandoned lots may be declared forfeited in accordance with RSA 289:18.

Upon receipt of a completed application the Cemetery Trustees shall confirm the availability of the requested lot(s) and issue a Certificate of Right to Inter. The Certificate along with a statement for the total cost of the lot shall be returned to the Purchaser. The signed certificate along with full payment shall be returned to the Cemetery Trustees within 30days or the lots shall be deemed again available for sale. Once a Certificate and payment have been returned timely to the Cemetery Trustees, they shall sign and record the Certificate, returning the original to the Purchaser for their records.
