2. Discuss Plan/Ideas for educational outreach during corona virus:

Many ideas were tossed around. Everyone had a chance to speak. Also, Wayne suggested doing a survey to ask people what format they would prefer. Steve reminded us that the issue of cyano bacteria may be timely now, because heat waves can induce blooms. Virginia remarked that prevention of polluting runoff is a long term issue. Discussion about whether or not we should ask Jim Haney and Bob Craycraft again, now that they are probably busy preparing for fall classes. Jenn said why not politely ask, give them leeway.

Final decision: Steve and Wayne will collaborate on an email to be sent to both Jim and Bob to ask if they can help with some type of educational outreach and give them the choice of format and dates. We hope to hear back from them early next week and will plan to meet shortly thereafter.
