



#### Milton Celebrates Casey Road Conservation Land

Applause and inspiration were the order of the day at the trail-head to Casey Road Conservation Land in Milton on an early October 2021 Saturday morning. The occasion was held to celebrate conserving this town-owned forestland. Attendees were enthusiastic in expressing their appreciation, while speakers encouraged them to support land conservation and forestry education.

The festivities began with the unveiling of a new sign to welcome visitors to the property. The handmade sign, designed and crafted by Bill and Deb McCormack, was warmly applauded and praised for its attractiveness. Neighbor Jeff LeClair commented afterwards, "I'm incredibly happy about it. It really makes you appreciate [the land] even more."

After this auspicious start, the group enjoyed refreshments and re-gathered at the trailhead. The first speaker, Cynthia Wyatt, long-time Chair of the Milton Conservation Commission (CC), was introduced by new CC Chair Virginia Long, who appreciated Wyatt for her inspiring leadership and many years of service.

# A Local Timber Harvest



Local Timber Harvest Workshop on **December 4** 

The Milton Conservation Commission (MCC) will offer a free Timber Harvest Workshop on Saturday, December 4, from 9 to 11 am at a local tree farm on Hare Road in Milton. Retired forester Jonathan Nute will give an educational tour of a 2-acre harvest area, part of his 11-acre woodlot that is protected by conservation easement.

Before retiring to family land in Milton, Nute served for 29 years as Forest Resources Extension Educator for UNH Cooperative Extension in Hillsborough County and has received awards for his work as a forester and educator. He currently serves on the Board of Moose Mountains Regional Greenways and the Milton Planning Board. Participants of his previous guided walks at nearby Casey Road Conservation Land have been enthusiastic about how much knowledge they gained about the ecological history of that land. The upcoming workshop will be an opportunity for Milton residents and friends to learn about managing a woodlot, including harvesting decisions and practices, logging equipment, and maple sugaring. Preregistration is helpful but not required. The MCC may be contacted at mcc@miltonnh-us.com. The workshop will be held rain or shine; in the case of inclement weather, the gathering will take place in the hay barn. Cars may be parked in the field across from the white mailbox #45 on Hare Road.

The mission of the Milton Conservation Commission is to provide for the proper utilization and protection of the natural resources and watershed resources in the Town of Milton, in accordance with NH RSA 36-A. 

Start the online hunter education course

**Please Note:** For the remainder of 2021, both traditional courses and field days are available only for New Hampshire residents age 12 and older. New Hampshire provides double certification for Hunter Education and Bowhunter Education in all certification courses except Trapper Education. There is no separate Bowhunter education course.

Anyone unable to attend a course for the 2021 fall hunting seasons should consider the apprentice hunting license. Individuals who purchase an apprentice license can hunt with a fully licensed hunter age 18 or older without taking Hunter Education first. The apprentice license is a one-time purchase opportunity. This year's apprentice license will expire on December 31, 2021. https://www.wildlife.state.nh.us/hunting/
