

SOLAR ENERGY EXEMPTION

Filing Deadline April 15th

(preceding the setting of the tax rate)

The Solar Exemption was adopted by a majority vote in 2022 to exempt the asses value of qualifying solar related equipment for property tax purposes. This exemption shall be in the amount of 100% of the assessed value of qualifying solar related equipment under the following statue:

NH RSA 72:61 Definition of a Solar Energy System NH RSA 72:62 Definition of a Solar Energy System

You must apply for this exemption

Physical copied may be obtained at the Assessing Office @ The Milton Town Hall.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- ⇒ Applicant must own the real estate which is equipped with a solar energy system on April 1st of the application year.
- ⇒ This exemption does not apply to those properties that generate electricity for resale.
- ⇒ The solar energy system must be installed and operational as of April 1st of the application year.
- ⇒ If the property is held in trust, a PA-33 form or "Statement of Qualification" form must be submitted with the application.

PLEASE BE AWARE IF YOU DO NOT APPLY FOR THIS EXEMPTION, YOU WILL BE ASSESSED FOR THE FULL VALUE OF YOUR SOLAR ENERGY SYSTEM.

- o Information and assistance regarding Medicare and Medicaid
- o Information about volunteer opportunities Investigation of reports of abuse, neglect or exploitation of incapacitated adults BEAS Locations BEAS staff are located at DHHS District Offices and ServiceLink Resource Centers throughout NH for administrative support and general program and financial planning.

Apple Grafting 101 with Jared Kane @ Branch Hill Farm, 307 Applebee Road, Milton Mills, NH 03852

This workshop will include an introductory presentation on apple grafting as well as hands-on training provided by orchardist and Branch Hill Farm Executive Director Jared Kane. By the end of the class, each person will have completed grafting their own small apple tree to take home, using a scion (living shoot) collected from one of several varieties of local heirloom trees. If time and weather permit, the group will take a short walk to tour the newly planted Preservation Orchard at Branch Hill Farm.

A minimum donation of \$10 to MMRG is being requested per person to register for this event. Registration is required by April 5th; however earlier registration is advised since the class size is limited to 20, and usually sells out quickly!
