Please find attached the 2022 Application for Holiday Assistance to Families in need. This is a needs-based program, not an income-based program.

In an effort to help defray the cost of the financial impact on our Milton/Milton Mills Residents who struggle at this time of year to keep up with their bills and still afford to give their dependent children a nice Holiday, the Milton Recreation Department and other departments in town have teamed up to offer this program to our families in need of support during the Holiday season. Your family does not need to be receiving other financial support from the town to qualify for this program. You just must have a need for support during the Holiday season to qualify. This is an honesty-based program and is in place to help our families who have a financial need at this time of the year.

Applications can be acquired from the Town of Milton Website, at both Milton Elementary and Nute High/Middle School nurses offices, Milton Town Hall and Milton Recreation Department at both Town Hall and the Milton Town Beach Recreation Office.

All information is confidential and is not shared with any other organizations. Once the application is filled out, you may return it to either Milton Recreation Department Office in the basement of Town Hall, Milton Town Beach Recreation Office, or mail to Recreation Department at PO Box 310, Milton, NH 03851.

All applications must be received on or before Friday, December 9th, 2022 @ 4:00 pm.

Gifts will be distributed during the week of December 12th, once your application is processed you will receive a call or e-mail to let you know when your families' gifts can be picked up.

No walk-ins allowed. If you have applied, you will be called.

We ask you to please be patient and work with us. In an effort to disburse all the gifts that we receive, we wait until all donations are in before we break them down into family packages, this will help us better serve all the families who have asked for our assistance.

We are aware that emergencies do happen, so if you find yourself in need after the December 9th deadline, please give us a call (603-652-4501 ext. 8 or 603-652-7308) and we will do our best to help. Emergency applications will be accepted on a case-by-case basis, and there are no guarantees that we will be able to accommodate, but we will try our best to help!
