A message from SAU64 - MILTON SD

In 2020, Article 13 was passed by Milton voters. It stated the following: "To see if the voters of the Milton School District shall direct the Milton School Board to enter into talks with neighboring School Districts to determine the feasibility of an Area Agreement according to RSA 195-a for the purpose of sending our high school and middle school students out of district."

With the passage of Article 13, the Middle/High School Exploration Committee was formed to investigate the feasibility of sending students out of the district. The Committee is gathering information from multiple sources, including community members, to determine community priorities. A survey was developed to give Milton residents an opportunity to share their thoughts and priorities.

Financial aid is available for many families, and our girls use troop funds earned during cookie season for activities and supplies resulting in very little family out of pocket cost.




