Milton Fire and Rescue

Milton Fire-Rescue is hosting a Holiday Coffee Hour on December 14th, if you are traveling by Central Station on Route 125, please stop in and enjoy a cup of coffee with us from 8 AM to 11 AM. We will take a few minutes to enjoy the holiday season and get to know the people of the community we serve. The "senior" members of Milton will receive a holiday gift bag while supplies last. Milton Public Safety Association is the sponsor of this gettogether and barring any emergency calls, Milton Fire and Police members will be on hand to meet and greet you.

November's weather reminds us that winter has arrived in New Hampshire. Last night Milton Fire-Rescue responded to several vehicles off the road due to icy conditions. The temperatures dropped well below freezing, the snow was blowing and the roads became very slick. Please know that it is the same every year, when the winter weather conditions arrive, people need to re-learn to slow down and drive with caution. As emergency responders, we find ourselves out on those roads trying to help the injured, reduce hazards and at the same time trying not to put ourselves in harms way. If you must be out in bad driving conditions, please remember we too, may be on the road trying to assist those who have had the misfortune of needing emergency assistance. When you see the red and/or blue flashing lights, please slow down and move over, per NH State Law:

Under New Hampshire state law (265:37-a), "When in or approaching an incident involving a fire, collision, disaster, or other emergency resulting in partial or complete blockage of a highway, or a location where a police officer has made a traffic stop, every driver other than the driver of an emergency response vehicle, shall:

- I. Maintain a reduced speed.
- II. Obey the directions of any authorized person directing traffic and of all applicable emergency signals and traffic control devices.
- III. Vacate as soon as possible any lane wholly or partially blocked.
- IV. Give a wide berth, without endangering oncoming traffic, to public safety personnel, any persons in the roadway, and stationary vehicles displaying blue, red, or amber emergency or warning lights."

Several people have requested information on the status of a new fire station. The Building Committee has been meeting with the architect and the 2014 financial figures are being calculated. The design remains the same and the hope continues for construction at the former Moose Lodge's site of 855 White Mountain Highway. All evidence points to an increase in the dollar amount and those numbers will be posted as soon as possible on the Milton Fire-Rescue web page and at www.miltonfirestation.com as soon as they are available.

Last year, 2013, the warrant article to build a new fire station failed to obtain the 3/5th majority of the vote by only 21 votes! Every vote counts in this community. If you are not able to make it to the polls whether due to wintering in a warmer climate, vacation or working out of town and the polls not being open when you are able to get there, you may request an **Absentee Ballot** from the Milton Tax Collector. The application for the ballot is the first step. Once the application is completed and returned to the tax collector, she will issue you an Absentee Ballot. These ballots are then completed and returned prior to voting day. Further information to obtain an Absentee Ballot is available on the Milton Town website, www.miltonnh-us.com/taxes.php.

As with every holiday season, Milton Fire-Rescue would like to encourage everyone to have a SAFE holiday by reducing the number of electrical extension cords you may be using. Please do not place furniture or rugs on electrical cords, nor run them in traffic areas which may lead to tripping or other damage. In addition, please check those smoke detectors and carbon monoxide detectors. If you have questions or concerns about your warning devices, please call us for information and assistance. Milton Fire-Rescue is here to serve you. For non-emergency assistance, please call: 652-4201, during day-time hours which are 6AM – 6 PM.


