Chairman Boyers called the meeting to order at 6:33pm. B. Boyers and brought B. Graham to the board as a voting member. The board has been requested to tape the meeting if they would like, board has no qualms.

Public Comment: None.

Approval of Minutes: August 1st meeting minutes, tabled till the October meeting.

Master Plan Update: Eric Knapp was present at the meeting to discuss the findings from the Master Plan survey. For the record E. Knapp stated that this survey was done as a voluntary citizen survey not published by the Planning Board, Conservation Commission or Economic Development Committee. 344 people responded to the survey, it was open to surrounding communities, most of the respondents were residents, 8 nonresident property owners responded to the survey. E. Knapp discussed the findings that resulted from the survey. The findings showed that the town is very pro-environment. Economic development was shown to be strongly desired in town. He found that a lot of people reached out to him expressing a care for the town and willingness to volunteer.

The board stated that E. Knapp did an excellent job.

Gearld Coogan will be present for the next meeting, he is going to review the survey results and comment on it during an open forum.

Groundwater Update: Kyle Pimental was present to continue discussing the Groundwater Ordinance Update and answer questions from the board. K. Pimental refreshed the board on where they were on the ground water update. By the next meeting there should be a response from the town attorney about hazardous waste. Attorney Sessler has the case law information on the Hookset case in regards to hazardous waste. B. Bourdeau was the one with the most questions and was not present for the meeting. D. Smith will contact B. Bourdeau to get his questions about the Groundwater Update and send them to K. Pimental.

Other Business: Cynthia Wyatt requested for the Planning Board to waive the fee for the lot line adjustment application. T. Gray said that it was not the Planning Board's decision it would be Board of Selectmen. Charlie Karcher will go to the meeting to speak with them.

L. Brown motions to adjourn the meeting. T. Gray seconds the motion. All in favor, meeting ended 7:00pm.
