Public Hearing on Conservation Funds for Jones Brook Park Project

Notice is hereby given in accordance with RSA 675:7 that the Milton Conservation Commission (MCC) will hold a Public Hearing regarding the proposed disbursement of conservation funds to a qualified organization for the purchase of property interests as authorized under RSA 36-A:4-a, I(b), on Wednesday, November 2 at 6:20 P.M. in the Milton Town Hall Conference Room, 424 White Mountain Highway, Milton, NH.

The land trust Moose Mountains Regional Greenways (MMRG) will present information regarding a project to conserve two contiguous town-owned parcels referred to as Jones Brook Park and the Payne Property, Tax Map 14/ Lot 2 and Tax Map 14/ Lot 6, totaling 23.5 acres. The project consists of placing a conservation easement on the referenced parcels, as previously mandated by town vote, with MMRG to be the easement holder.

Should a decision not be reached at the public hearing, the proposed expenditure will stay on the MCC agenda until such time it is either approved or disapproved.
