Claudine Burnham, Chair, opened the public session at 5:01 PM.

1.) Pledge of Allegiance: Claudine Burnham, Chair, led the meeting in the Pledge of Allegiance.

2.) Public Comment:

There were no public comments.

3.) Traffic Safety on Election Day:

Purpose of Meeting – The School Department could not close school on Tuesday September 13, 2022, so the Secretary of State – Election Division has been notified that the election is now going to be held downstairs in Town Hall, aka the Emma Ramsey Center.

H.W. – We have some concerns for safety on election day.

P.S- recommends that it be made one-way (*for vehicular traffic*) that day on Charles Street. (*One Way from Rte. 125 north to the Mill St intersection*)

R.K. – The police department can position one cruiser with its lights flashing all day in an attempt to slow north bound traffic down. Due to a lack of staffing we could use several public works department staff for the day.

P.S. – He has five (5) employee's who are flagger certified that could be assigned to the detail.

H.W. – suggests that we could use three (3) people. One (1) at the top of Charles St, one (1) at the exit from the Charles St parking lot and one (1) at Mill and Charles Steet intersection.

C.B. – recommends that we print flyers (for the Charles St residents), and she offers to deliver them.

Suggest that poll workers should park at the back of the parking lot.

Suggested that we print additional 8 ½ x 11-inch notices that let the public know the election is being held at the Emma. Chief Krauss will deliver them to the school.

Does Recreation still have any sandwich boards that we can use?

R.K. – Police will move the electronic message board in Milton Mills to the transfer station for the weekend.

Mr. Williams motioned to adjourn the public meeting. Mr. Morrill seconded the motion. All were in favor; the motion passed. The public meeting adjourned at 5:21 PM.
