Meeting call to order

Motion: R. Thibeault moved to enter into nonpublic session under 91-A: 3II (a).E. Hutchings seconded. 3-0

Motion: R. Thibeault moved to enter public session. E. Hutchings seconded. 3-0

Public Comment:

V. Long: Stated there is now an education committee for the Conservation Commission which is requesting participants regarding a brief survey to base interest of the residents of the town and surrounding areas of interest.

Stated the Casey Road Committee is hosting a dog walk during Winter Carnival Saturday morning March 7th.

New Business:

1. Heavy Hauling Exemption Request

E. Creveling stated this is an annual request of Paey Construction due to RSA 41:11 restrictions and the location of his residence.

Motion: R. Thibeault moved to approve the heavy hauling exemption request of Paey Construction regarding travel on Allen Hastings Way and Piggot Hill Roads. A Rawson seconded. 3-0

2. Conservation Commission Alternate Appointment Request

V. Long submitted a letter of interest to continue as an alternate member on the Conservation Commission.

Motion: A. Rawson moved to approve the appointment of alternate member Virginia Long to the Conservation Commission. E. Hutchings seconded. 3-0

3. Casey Road Committee Discussion

K. Golab of the Casey Road Committee stated the committee is interested in merging an additional 4-acre parcel of property to the already existing 79-acre parcel referred to as the Casey Road Conservation Land. Invited the Board of Selectmen to a site walk to

pursue options of merging the two parcels. A. Rawson questioned the planning boards decision when they discussed the intent with them. K. Golab stated the planning board believes the parcel could be sold for profit rather than conserving the property. L. McDougall stated the planning board put in place a condition of revisiting the request after a year of the property being listed and no final sale. A. Rawson stated he would be interested in reviewing the property and discuss options afterwards. V. Long stated there is currently a right of way on the property with potential of a shared driveway for any future building. R. Thibeault stated the Town Administrator can contact K. Golab to establish potential dates for the board to perform a site walk of the property in question.

4. Seal Bid Opening for Ladder Truck

R. Thibeault stated there have been two bids received for the purchase of the 1984 Mack ladder truck.

Motion: R. Thibeault moved to accept the bid of \$2,775. for the purchase of the 1984 Mack ladder truck. E. Hutchings seconded. 3-0.

5. Milton NH/ Lebanon ME 40658 Municipal Agreement Update

E. Creveling stated Town Planner Woodruff has spent a great deal of time understanding and continuing with the process of this bridge project and suggested tabling the discussion until he was present to speak of the status. Explained the State of Maine is looking into the future of the project with nothing established currently.


