Article 2: Operating Budget "Shall the Milton School District raise and appropriate as an operating budget, not including appropriations by special warrant articles and other appropriations voted separately, the amounts set forth on the budget posted with the warrant or as amended by vote of the first session, for the purposes set forth therein, totaling \$11,595,762. Should this article be defeated, the default budget shall be \$11,613,975, which is the same as last year, with certain adjustments required by the previous action of the Milton School District or by law, or the governing body may hold one special meeting, under RSA 40:13, X and XVI, to take up the issue of a revised operating budget only." NOTE: Warrant article 2 (operating budget) does not include appropriations in any other warrant article. The total operating budget will be offset by federal, local, and state revenues by \$4,795,188, leaving a net budget amount of \$6,800,574 (RSA 32:5 III). The amount of \$4,795,188 will not be raised by taxation. Estimated Tax Impact of the School District's Proposed Operating Budget is \$13.48/\$1,000.
