### 2020 Milton Seasonal Boat Pass

**Weekends:** Memorial Day to Labor Day

**Weekdays:** June 15<sup>th</sup> to September 6<sup>th</sup>, 2020

Operation Hours from 8am to 8pm (*weather permitting*)

*We will also be open any day that the temperature reaches 80 degrees before June 15<sup>th</sup>. You may call the gatehouse at 652-7308 after 8:30 am to check to see if we are open.*

Welcome to our Milton Town Beach Facility! This pass entitles you to 20 boat/watercraft launches during the 2019 Season and is for your use only. This regulation will be strictly enforced. Any misuse of your pass will result in your pass being revoked without reimbursement for the cost of the pass. You must present your boat pass upon arrival.

All facility rules must be followed at all times. Please pick up after yourself, as this is a carry in/carry out facility. If you forgot a trash bag, ask for one at the gatehouse. A receptacle is available at the exit gate. Grills should be extinguished, all debris removed and never left unattended.

All boats/watercrafts must be loaded and ready to exit the premises by or before the 8pm closing time. Absolutely NO power loading on/off the ramp. Docking is only permitted when loading/unloading. Boats shall not be allowed to operate around or across the swim lines, nor shall they be allowed to moor to allow the occupants to swim inside the swim lines. Such intrusion shall be considered trespassing and any damages caused shall be assessed against said trespasser in addition to charges for criminal trespass, or otherwise. All boats/watercraft should be cleaned of any plant matter from other lakes/ponds before entering.

We close promptly at 8pm. Please plan your time accordingly. If your vehicle gets locked on the premises because you did not exit the property at closing time, you must call the Milton Police Department at 652-4500 to have them open the gate for you. Repeated failure to comply with this regulation will result in your pass being revoked without reimbursement for the cost of the pass.

**PARKING:** Please park cars in the lot straight ahead of the gate house. Vehicles with trailers park by the restrooms/changing rooms. Please make sure you do not box anyone in. Handicapped parking is located to the right of the Gazebo. No vehicles/trailers are to be left in the launch area. Once your boat/watercraft is launched, you must move your vehicle & trailer to the appropriate parking area. Violators will be reported to the Police Department.

Enjoy your stay!
