Application for Driveway Permit

Pursuant to the provisions under RSA 236: 13 (v) and amendments thereto, permission is requested to construct a driveway entrance per the Town of Milton Driveway Regulations, as amended. The driveway entrance shall be at a width of 30-feet and funnel to no less than 12-feet for 150-foot driveways. For driveways over 150-feet, the driveway shall funnel to no less than 20-feet. A culvert shall be used as specified by the Public Works Director. Dig Safe shall be contacted by the applicant and all dig safe points shall be marked prior to application submittal.

As the landowner/applicant, I hereby agree to the following:

- l. Post a \$500.00 Surety Bond, (Letter of Credit or Escrow Account) listing the Town of Milton as obligee.
- 2. To construct driveway entrances only for the purpose of securing access to private property such that the highway right of way is used for no other purpose than travel.
- 3. To construct driveway entrances at permitted location in accordance with State Statutes, all provision of the Driveway Regulation for driveway entrances issued by the Town of Milton
- 4. To hold harmless the Town of Milton, and its duly appointed agent/employees against any action for personal injury and/or property damage sustained by reason of the exercise of this permit.
- 5. To furnish and install drainage structures that are necessary to maintain existing highway drainage and adequately handle increase runoff resulting from development.
- 6. A sketch of the proposed driveway location or approved Subdivision plats are to be provided.

APPLICATION/PERMIT FOR DRIVEWAY Town of Milton Fire Department Driveway Policies

As referenced in the Town of Milton Driveway Ordinance, and the National Fire Protection Association's (NFPA) Uniform Fire Code, as adopted by the State of NH, the requirements for driveways are outlined below.

These requirements apply to new driveways longer than 150 feet, or shared driveways serving more than one property.

1. All driveways longer than 150' in length shall be at least 20 feet wide of a material suitable to support the weight of Fire apparatus. This does not mean the entire 20 feet width shall be paved, but it needs to be level and built with suitable material to maintain all season driving.

2. The entire width of the driveway needs to have a turnaround of sufficient width, length and material to support the weight and length of fire apparatus.

3. These requirements can be changed with the installation of NFPA sprinkler systems within the residence.

If there are any questions regarding these requirements, please contact the Milton Fire Department. The driveway ordinance is available on request with the Planning Board and the NFPA code reference in NFPA 1, Chapter 18.
