SCHOOL WARRANT ARTICLES

Article 2: "Shall the Milton School District raise and appropriate as an operating budget, not including appropriations by special warrant articles and other appropriations voted separately, the amounts set forth on the budget posted with the warrant or as amended by vote of the first session, for the purposes set forth therein, totaling eight million, eight hundred ninety-five thousand, seven hundred, thirty-eight dollars (\$8,895,738). Should this article be defeated, the default budget shall be eight million nine hundred thirty-eight thousand, eight hundred thirty-five dollars (\$8,938,835), which is the same as last year, with certain adjustments required by previous action of the Milton School District or by law; or the governing body may hold one special meeting, in accordance with RSA 40:13, X and XVI, to take up the issue of a revised operating budget only."

The school board recommends this appropriation (4 - 1).
The budget committee recommends this appropriation (7 - 0 - 1 Abstention).

Article 3: "Shall the voters of the Milton School District adopt a School Administrative Unit budget of nine hundred twenty-five thousand, six hundred fifty-three dollars (\$925,653) for the forthcoming fiscal year in which four hundred two thousand eleven dollars (\$402,011) are assigned to the school budget of this school district. This year's adjusted budget of nine hundred eighteen thousand, four hundred thirty-two dollars (\$918,432) with three hundred ninety-eight thousand, eight hundred seventy five dollars (\$398,875) assigned to the school budget of this school district, will be adopted if the article does not receive a majority vote of all the school district voters voting in this school administrative unit."
