Article 2: To see if the Milton School District will vote to approve the cost items included in the Collective Bargaining Agreement reached between the Milton School Board and the Milton Education Association, which calls for the following increase in salaries and benefits at the current staffing levels:

	Estimated Increase
Year 2015-16	\$122,793
Year 2016-17	\$118,440

and further to raise and appropriate the sum of one hundred twenty-two thousand, seven hundred ninety-three dollars (\$122,793) for the 2015-2016 school year, such sum representing the additional costs attributable to the increase in salaries and benefits over those of the appropriation at current staffing levels paid in the prior fiscal school year.

SCHOOL WARRANT ARTICLES CONTINUED

Article 4: "Shall the Milton School District vote to raise and appropriate as an operating budget, not including appropriations by special warrant articles and other appropriations voted separately, the amounts set forth on the budget posted with the warrant or as amended by vote of the first session, for the purposes set forth therein, totaling nine million, three hundred sixty-four thousand, seven hundred twenty-nine dollars (\$9,364,729). Should this article be defeated, the default budget shall be nine million, two hundred seventy-seven thousand, nine hundred twenty-seven dollars (\$9,277,927), which is the same as last year, with certain adjustments required by previous action of the Milton School District or by law; or the governing body may hold one special meeting, in accordance with RSA 40:13, X and XVI, to take up the issue of a revised operating budget only?"

NOTE: The total operating budget will be offset by federal grant revenues of two hundred ninety-four thousand, five hundred dollars (\$294,500) leaving a net budget amount of nine million, seventy thousand, two hundred twenty-nine dollars (\$9,070,229) (RSA 32:5 III). The amount of \$294,500 will not be raised by taxation. This article does not include appropriations in any other warrant articles.

NOTE: The total default budget will be offset by federal grant revenues of two hundred ninety-four thousand, five hundred dollars (\$294,500) leaving a net budget amount of eight million, nine hundred eighty-three thousand, four hundred twenty-seven dollars (\$8,983,427) (RSA 32:5 III). The amount of \$294,500 will not be raised by taxation. This article does not include appropriations in any other warrant articles.

Article 5: "Shall the voters of Milton School District adopt a School Administrative Unit budget one million seven hundred forty-four thousand, three hundred ninety-two dollars (\$1,744,392) for the forthcoming fiscal year in which four hundred three thousand six hundred thirty-five dollars (\$403,635) are assigned to the school budget of the Milton School District. This year's adjusted budget of one million seven hundred thirty thousand, six hundred ten dollars (\$1,730,610) with three hundred ninety-seven thousand, six hundred forty-nine dollars (\$397,649) assigned to the school budget of the Milton School District, will be adopted if the article does not receive a majority vote of all the school district voters voting in this school administrative unit."

NOTE: The total SAU Budget will be offset by revenues of eight hundred fifteen thousand (\$815,000) not to be raised through taxation for this article, leaving a net budget amount of nine hundred twenty-nine thousand, three hundred ninety-two dollars (\$929,392) to be apportioned between the Wakefield and Milton School Districts, with four hundred three thousand six hundred thirty-five dollars (\$403,635) assigned to the Milton School District. (RSA 32:5 III)

NOTE: The total default SAU Budget will be offset by revenues of eight hundred fifteen thousand (\$815,000) not to be raised through taxation for this article, leaving a net budget amount of nine hundred fifteen thousand, six hundred ten dollars (\$915,610) to be apportioned between the Wakefield and Milton School Districts, with three hundred ninety-seven thousand, six hundred forty-nine dollars (\$397,649) assigned to the Milton School District. (RSA 32:5 III)
