Article 2: "Shall the Milton School District vote to raise and appropriate as an operating budget, not including appropriations by special warrant articles and other appropriations voted separately, the amounts sat forth on the budget posted with the warrant or as amended by vote of the first ession, for the purposes set forth therein, totaling nine million, eight hundred forty-eight dollars and eighty-four cents (\$9,844,248.84)? Should this article be defeated, the default budget shall be nine million, eight hundred thirty-three thousand, four hundred seventy-two dollars and thirty-four cents (\$9,833,472.34), which is the same as last year, with certain adjustments required by previous action of the Milton School District or by law; or the governing body may hold one special meeting, in accordance with RSA 40:13, X and XVI, to take up the Issue of a revised operating budget only."						
NOTE: The total operating budget will be offset by federal grant revenues of four hundred forty-one thousand, seven hundred four dollars (\$441,704) leaving a <b>net budget amount of nine million, four hundred two thousand, five hundred forty-four dollars and eighty-four cents (\$9,402,544.84) (RSA 32:5 lit). The amount of \$441,704 will not be raised by taxation. This article does not include appropriations in any other warrant articles.</b>
